Disclosure of Costs

DataMotion Direct Secure Messaging V. 6.6

DataMotion Direct is offered as a communication service providing Direct Secure Messaging functionality compliant with the ONC Transport and Security Specification in §170.299, including compliance with certification criteria:

- 170.315 (d) (1): Authentication, Access Control, and Authorization
- 170.315 (d) (2): Auditable Events and Tamper-Resistance
- 170.315 (d) (3): Audit Reports
- 170.315 (g) (4): Quality Management System
- 170.315 (g) (5): Accessibility-Centered Design
- 170.315 (h) (2): Direct, Edge, and XDR/XDM

The fee structure for DataMotion Direct contains the following components. Not all fee components may be necessary for all customers or implementations of DataMotion Direct:

- Set-up/configuration
 - One-time fee
 - Services include: web portal, XDR interface, Web Services API interfaces, Management console configuration and training.
- Certificates
 - Annual fee per certificate
 - Individual and Organizational X.509 digital certificates issued by DataMotion in its capacity as a Certificate Authority following Registration Authority validation of the individual or organizational identity. Registration Authority fees are included in the Certificate fee.
- Addresses/seats/users
 - Annual fee per direct secure messaging address or user or registered “seat”
- Transactions
 - Tiered pricing structure for per message-based fees
 - Payable as either pre-purchase of set volume or monthly billable measurement of volume
- Maintenance/extended support
 - Monthly or annual billing depending upon contract
 - Fees typically a percentage of initial setup/configuration
 - Additional fees for 24x7 support, dedicated engineer support, etc.

At a minimum, all DataMotion Direct services must have an address, certificate and interface for use.



Integration and set up fees may be charged to integrate DataMotion's certified Health IT technology with a hospital's other certified EHR Modules or a health information exchange organization. Specific rates, fees and billing structure may be adjusted to match DataMotion's clients' needs and business models.

DataMotion agrees to notify Drummond Group of any and all future changes to our disclosure language for this certified product-version. DataMotion understands and agrees that the ONC HIT Certification Program Final Rule statement gives Drummond Group, as an ONC-ACB, the sole responsibility for ensuring compliance and determining appropriate consequences if EHR technology developers fail to disclose accurate cost information. DataMotion understands and agrees that it will provide to Drummond Group copies of or give access to any and all websites, marketing materials, communication statements, and other assertions made by our organization regarding the ONC certification status of our product in a reasonable time to ensure the cost information is being accurately disclosed.
